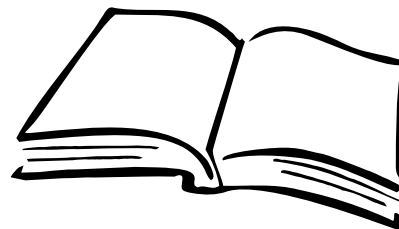


God Speaks, We Listen

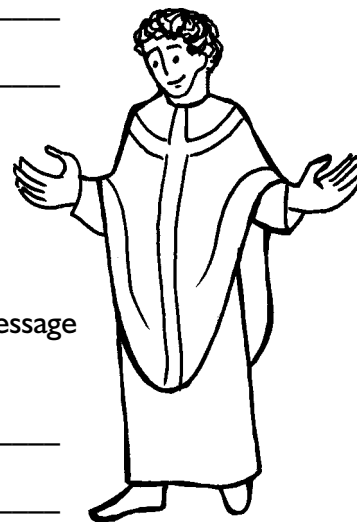
1. Briefly describe a story you remember from the Bible.
