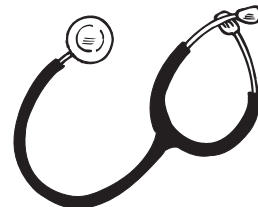

_____ 1. Dorothy Day

a. A dedicated doctor, he founded MEDICO, an organization that secured medical supplies for Third World countries. He also served Vietnamese refugees in Laos.



_____ 2. Tom Dooley

b. Founder of the Catholic Worker movement, she helped the poor, published a newspaper, and spoke out in support of peace and justice.



_____ 3. Mother Teresa

c. She served the poor in the world, especially in Calcutta, India. She founded an order of Sisters who continue her work.



_____ 4. Cesar Chavez

d. A priest and later an archbishop, he worked for justice and against military dictatorship in El Salvador. He was assassinated while celebrating the Eucharist.



_____ 5. Oscar Romero

e. He helped migrant workers in the U.S. by founding the United Farm Workers of America and by working for justice for poor immigrants.
