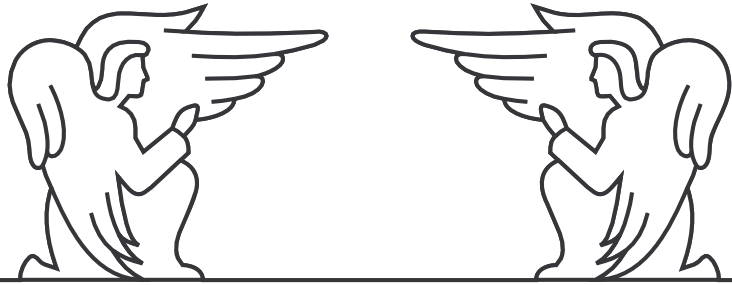


# First Things First
