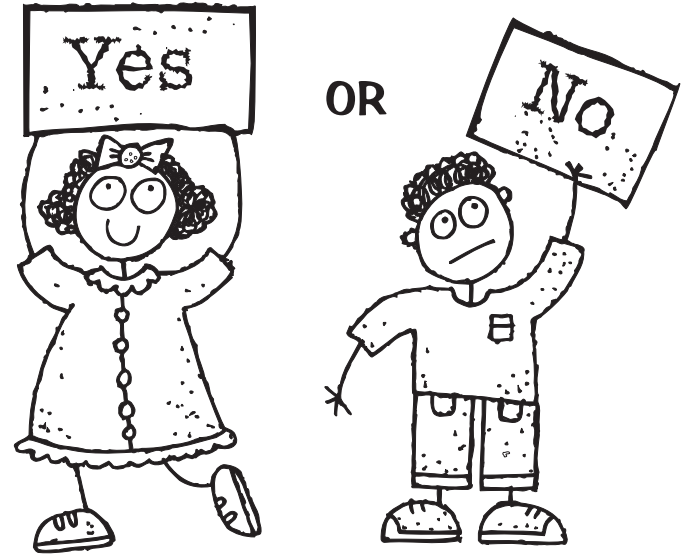


Yes or No?
