

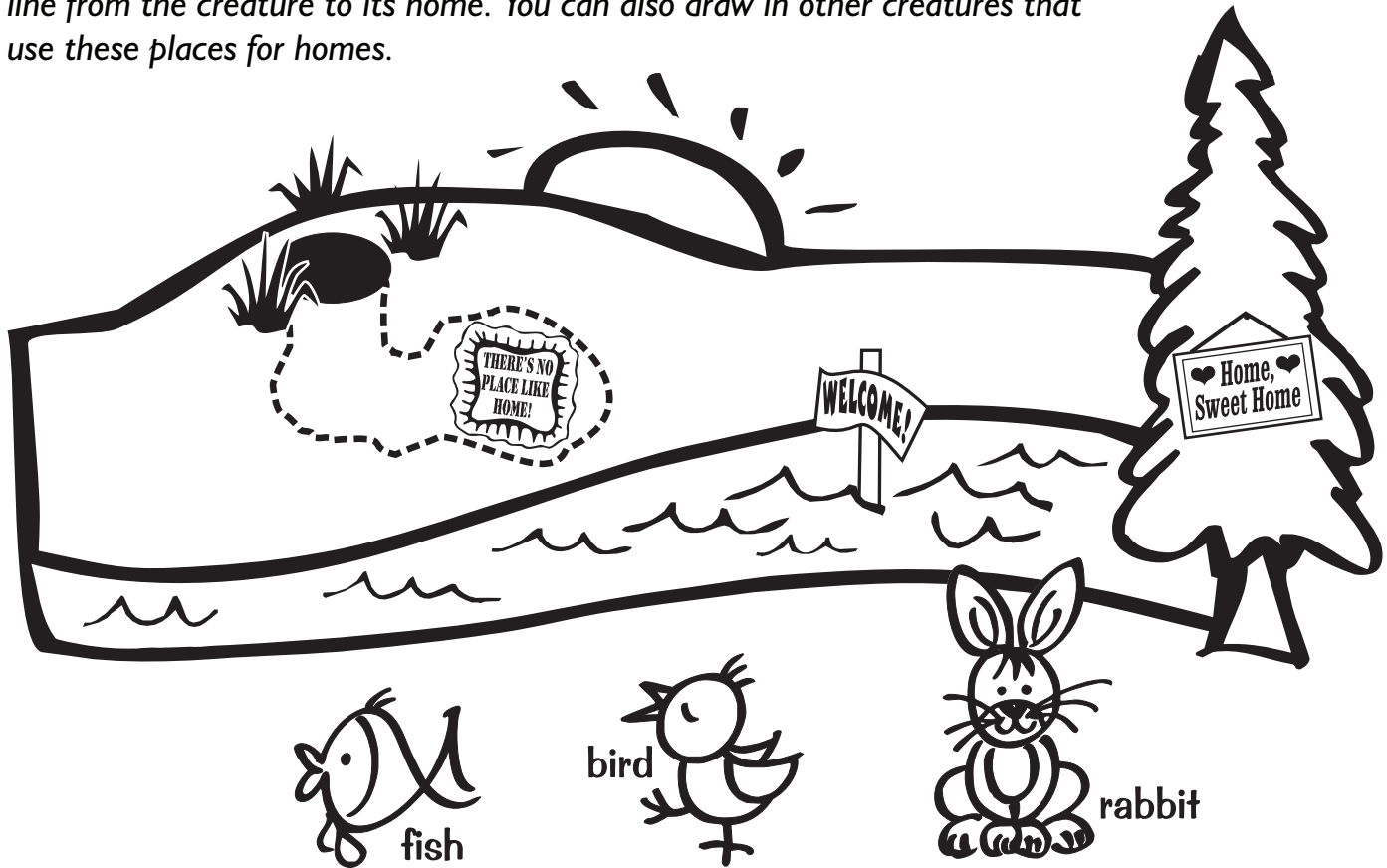
All Living Creatures
