

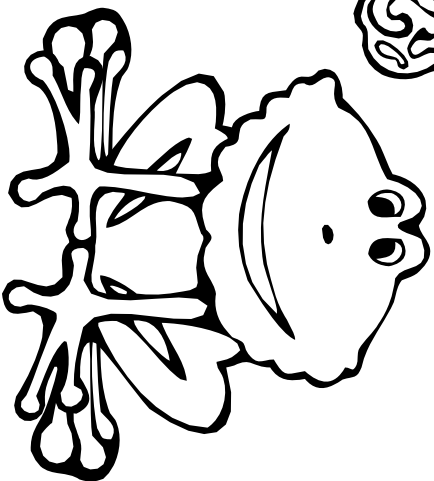
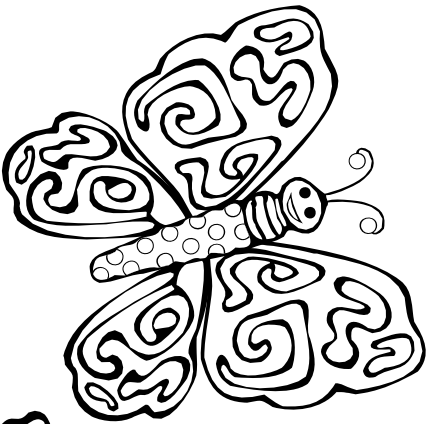
Take Care of the Food Source for Wild Animals

Plant special gardens for wildlife with wild grasses and grains. Get a book at your library that describes the wildlife in your area and what they eat.



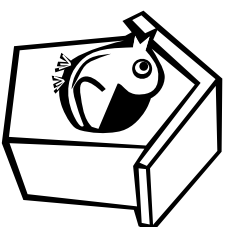
Don't Pollute
