2. He considered himself a Roman. That means he probably spoke 7 12 as a youth.
3. When he was young, Patrick lived in England. He was kidnapped by 32 34 4 slave traders and carried to their island homeland to the west of England.
4. Patrick was sold to a master who made him a 26 10 35 22.
(Hint: Angels announced the birth of Jesus to men of this same occupation.)
5. When he was 23, Patrick escaped back to his family in 20 3 17 18. While he had been held captive, Patrick became so aware of God's love that he decided to be a 8 28.
6. Patrick not only became a 33 27 9 but he was also elevated to the rank of 23 14 29 21.
7. Patrick knew the pagan Irish needed to hear about Jesus' 24 30 for us, so he went back to 25 1, where he had been a slave.
8. Patrick converted the whole country to Christianity. He used the 5 15 16 to explain the 13 6, the mystery of three persons in one 19.
